

# **Summary: Format, Championship and Regulations TCR Middle East Series 2019**

## **Sporting Format**

### Each Weekend:

- Free Practice: 30 minutesSprint Qualifying: 30 minutesEndurance Qualifying: 30 minutes
- Races
  - 2x 30 minutes (standing start)
  - o 1x Endurance Race (rolling start)
- Grid:
  - o Race 1: As per Qualifying results
  - o Race 2: Qualifying top-ten in reverse order
  - o Endurance race: As per Endurance Qualifying results
- Drivers:
  - One driver or fixed crew of two drivers for sprint races
  - Two up to five drivers for endurance race
- Cars:
  - All TCR cars homologated by WSC ltd
  - o All cars that are eligible in the TCR class of the 24H SERIES

# Championship

TCR Middle East Series Championship (For teams\* and drivers):

- Qualifying Points
- Points per Sprint Race
- Bonus points for endurance race
  - o Driver needs to drive at least 1H during endurance race
  - o Team needs to drive at least 2H in endurance race
- Junior Cup:
  - Separate ranking for drivers born 1995 or later
  - Points are taken 1:1 from the drivers' standings
- DSG Trophy:
  - o Separate ranking for teams and drivers with DSG cars
  - o Points are taken 1:1 from the drivers' and team standings

TCR Middle East Endurance Trophy (For teams\* and drivers):

- Points per endurance race

\*For teams' championships: One team is defined as one car





### **Regulations Summary:**

- Code 60 instead of safety car
- Drivers: Open for drivers with:
  - National UAE license
  - International license (grade D or C minimum)
- Mandatory equipment:
  - o AMB/Mylaps transponder (with or without driver-ID)
  - AiM Evo4 or Evo5 datalogger
  - Drivers: HANS/FHR System
- Hankook tires:
  - Affordable prices (335 EURO/Tire)
  - o Number of tires is free
  - o Mandatory size: maximum 260/660R18
- Podium ceremony: Four trophies presented after each race for:
  - Winning driver(s)
  - Second driver(s) classified
  - Third driver (s) classified
  - Representative of the winning team
  - Minimum weight of the car is with empty fuel tank and WITH driver
- Fuel Station: At all races, a central fuel station will be used, no fuel equipment required
  - o All fuel consumption included in entry fee
  - o Fuel grade: RON98

## **Technical regulations:**

- Generally, the TCR Technical regulations published by WSC ltd apply
- Eligible cars:
  - All TCR cars homologated by WSC ltd
  - All cars that are eligible in the TCR class of the 24H SERIES
- All cars must be able to refuel with a standard commercial fuel pistol
- o Starting numbers and advertising stickers will be provided by the promoter
